Fred Thomas Park Pavilion, funded by the Stapleton Development Corporation, and located in the park adjacent to the Stapleton Redevelopment, creates a strong architectural center for the park, while serving as a functional, versatile amphitheatre with covered seating for 48 people. The design incorporates sustainable building concepts, and provides comfortable, all season enjoyment for park users.



The Fred Thomas Park Pavilion represents a new direction for mixed-use design employed at the Stapleton site. The Pavilion also incorporates a central recreation area, a greenway, and several playing fields.



Fred Thomas Pavilion is part of a one quarter circular plan that not only relates to the surrounding playing field but also to the park's overall greenway design. The Pavilion utilizes materials and construction methods typical of the structures built for the Stapleton airport redevelopment project, retaining a unique design character.
