



## Historic Structural Assessments *for the Colorado State Historic Fund*



**Cameron Church** embodies openness and light within the congregation and in the building itself. The congregation believed the renovation of their building needed to reflect the nature and spirit of the Cameron congregation. UNiT, the selected renovation firm, respected their goals and this philosophy by suggesting an open community center filled with light that penetrated the stained glass windows. Approved December 24, 2003.



**430 Year Church of God in Christ**, located at 701 East 23rd Avenue and Washington Street, wanted to restore the Church's structure to its original design character. To make this possible, Historic Denver Inc. selected UNiT design studio for the Historic assessment of the building. UNiT design studio also assisted Historic Denver, Inc., and the owner of the Church with the grant application. Approved August 18, 2003.



**Epworth United Methodist Church**, built in 1908 and located on the corner of 34th Avenue and High Street, provided a unique historic preservation opportunity for UNiT design studio. Epworth wished to upgrade the facility, restore the historic structure and provide expanded child care services and programs. With this intention, and a grant from Historic Denver, Inc., UNiT was selected to provide a historic assessment of the historic structure. Approved June 30, 2003.
