Sibley Residence *Denver, Colorado*

The Sibley residence was an arts and crafts house built in 1911 at the beginning of the construction of the Congress Park neighborhood in Denver. The home had suffered serious neglect over the decades and was partially renovated in early 2000 however the exterior and many interior elements remained in very dilapidated and compromised condition. UNIT design studio worked with the client to develop a revival architectural language for the exterior while creating a modern interior that still respected the home's heritage from the early 20th Century.



The exterior was completely rebuilt to include revived arts and crafts elements, structures and details. The interior was opened up and expanded to include new living areas, modernized functions and revitalized spaces. The result is a comfortable and stylish family home, fully modernized with clear and detailed references to the home's arts and crafts heritage.
